It was posted because the board was disappointed with their website, and a board member asked me to put up a "trial" site for the board's consideration. I was reluctant to do that because there is no way to give an idea of what a site would be like without creating the entire site. In the interest of having a good site for Kentlands, however, I did develop and post the website.</p> <p>The board wanted more proposals and chose another provider. That site is very nice too.</p> <p>A number of you have urged me to continue Kentlands Dot Us and nearly everyone I spoke with last summer said that they would prefer to have a website that is independent from the board, especially for the forum. I decided to do as you suggested and continue the site. It does not make sense to me, however, to have duplicate sites. Kentlands Dot Us, therefore, is changing focus to become a web magazine.</p> <p>There are a number of things that the official site can do best—such as the calendar, the documents, and the weekly express.</p> <p>There are other things that would not be appropriate for the board sponsored site, and that is what Kentlands Dot Us will focus on.</p> <p>We will no longer include the documents page since it is not only easier for the board</p>

to keep those materials updated, it is also their obligation.

Similarly, since I am not e-mailed the Kentlands Express, that is easier for the board site to post, and they have been planning to post it for quite some time.

Kentlands Dot Us is including columns and articles and is going to add restaurant reviews—sent in by readers: you. We will include only positive reviews; absence of a review once we get a number of postings will function as a negative review. Feel free to send a picture with your restaurant review.

The forum is being expanded. You can send in questions and comments for the columnists from there as well.

So—keep sending pictures, and let me know that you really mean it when you tell me that you love the site by sending in reviews, commenting in the forum, and submitting columns for consideration. This is a good time to get in on advertising to be high on the list. Remember that for the time being, for sale, rent, lost and found, etc, ads by residents will be free of charge.
